

A case of deep infiltrating endometriosis requiring ureteric resection, psoas hitch and ureteric preimplantation

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A 42 year old lady presented with severe debilitating dysmenorrhoea. MRI scan revealed right hydroureter and hydronephrosis with a 2cm endometriotic nodule responsible for the obstruction at the midureteric region. A laparoscopic resection of endometriosis and ureter was performed. The remaining length of the right ureter was reimplanted to the bladder via a psoas hitch approach. Post operative recovery was uneventful.
