A young 35 years old woman, wanted to have a second child -because two year after delivery she was not pregnant, a ultrasound was performed and discover two big endometriomas of 9 cm in each ovary.
The MRI found on the right ovary a double cyst (one endometrioma of 8cm and another cyst of 6 cm describe like teratoma) on the left part à 8 cm endometrioma and both utero-sacral ligament-the multi-disciplinary discussion conclude that surgery should be performed
During laparoscopy, a pediculated small tumor of 2 cm is found on the right ovary
This tumor is taken on Frozen exam and found to be a sero papillary borderline tumor
The cysts was removed all
The final exam confirm the borderline tumor
The big cysts on right was teratoma and endometrioma
On the left ovary, endometrioma was confirm
The stadification surgery was perform (infracolic omentectomy and multiple peritoneal biopsy and removalof right ovary because of big hématome on ovary and did not shown any disease
Now the patient is under follow up
In conclusion, we discover a small pediculated borderline sero-papillary tumor among very big endometriomas
The volume of endometriomas made the analysis of the MRI very difficult
